- To organise training programmes in selected fields geared to the needs of the Member States as well as to the general objectives of the Organization of the Islamic Cooperation (OIC)

I. Statistics Department

- SESRIC is the major socio-economic information bank on and for OIC Member States
- collecting processing disseminating data to all relevant institutions and interested individuals
- Regularly sending questionnaires to NSOs of member states
- BASEIND : main statistical database
 - O Data on 253 socio-economic variables under 17 categories for 57 OIC Member States dating back to 1970
 - Possible to make research over country, theme and year
 - Updated regularly, member states can enter their information
 - Free and easy access
- Motion Charts (trends of several indicators over time) and Thematic Maps (comparative situation of the OIC Member States for the given theme with varying colors)
- Publishing Statistical Yearbook of OIC Countries and Basic Facts and Figures on OIC Member Countries






- SESRIC is the focal point for implementing and promoting coordination among relevant institutions in enhancing training activities in the OIC Member States
